

Q U I T C L A I M D E E D .

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 27th day of July A. D., 1928,
by and between OKLAHOMA RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation duly or-
ganized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State
of Oklahoma, party of the first part, and THE PUBLIC, party of the
second part, W I T N E S S E T H:

That said party of the first part, in consideration of
the sum of One Dollars (\$1.00) to it in hand paid, the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby quitclaim, grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, all
its right, title, interest, estate and every claim and demand, both
at law and in equity, in and to all of the following described pro-
perty, situated in Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma:

A strip of land thirty (30) feet in width lying
in the center of Noble Avenue, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma,
and extending from the Southeast line of the right of
way of the Oklahoma Railway Company in the center
of Exchange Avenue to the center line of Western
Avenue, the same being shown on the recorded plat
of Delmar Garden Addition to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma,
as the right of way of the Oklahoma Railway Company,

(Said property is not now and never has been a homestead or any
part thereof and is being dedicated to the public for street pur-
poses only).

together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances
thereunto belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises unto the
said THE PUBLIC (for street purposes) forever, so that neither it,
the said Oklahoma Railway Company, or any person in its name and
behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title
to the said premises or any part thereof; but shall by these
presents be excluded and forever barred.
