ORDINANCE NO. 23,821

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ZONING AND PLANNING CODE; AMENDING SECTIONS 3350.3, 3400.3, AND 3450.3, OF ARTICLE III, OF CHAPTER 59 OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL CODE, 2007, AS AMENDED; BY AMENDING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE URBAN DESIGN COMMISSION, THE BRICKTOWN URBAN DESIGN COMMITTEE AND THE STOCKYARDS CITY URBAN DESIGN COMMITTEE.

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY:

SECTION 1. That Sections 3300.3, 3350.3, 3400.3, and 3450.3 of Article III, of Chapter 59 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2007, as amended, are hereby amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 59

ZONING

ARTICLE III. ADMINISTRATIVE BODIES AND OFFICIALS

§ 59-3350 URBAN DESIGN COMMISSION

* * *

§ 3350.3 Membership, Terms and Organization

A. Membership.

The Urban Design Commission shall consist of nine members, whom the Mayor shall appoint with the consent and approval of the City Council. The Urban Design Commission shall be composed as follows:

~~(1) One (1) member shall be a member of the Panning Commission.~~

~~(2)~~ (1) One member shall be a member of the Traffic Commission.

~~(3)~~ (2) Five citizen members shall be property or business owners, or representatives of such owners in locations subject to Urban Design Commission review. No more than two such members shall be from the same Urban Design District. In lieu of this requirement, one such member may be a member of another City Design Review Committee or Commission.

~~(4)~~ (3) Two citizen(s) members shall be employed in the planning, design or land development professions, and who are knowledgeable in the field of historic preservation, and at least one of whom shall be a registered architect.

(4) One member shall be a resident citizen of The City of Oklahoma City with demonstrated knowledge of the District.

§ 59-3400 BRICKTOWN URBAN DESIGN COMMITTEE

§ 3400.3 Membership, Terms and Organization

A. Membership.

The Bricktown Urban Design Committee shall consist of five members, whom the Mayor shall appoint with the consent and approval of the City Council. The Bricktown Urban Design Committee shall be composed as follows:

~~(1) Two (2) members shall be members of the Planning Commission.~~

~~(2)~~ (1) One citizen member shall be an architect knowledgeable in the field of historic preservation.

~~(3)~~ (2) ~~Two (2)~~ Three citizen members shall be owners or tenants within the BC District. In lieu of this requirement, one such member may be a member of another City Design Review Committee or Commission.

(3) One member shall be a resident citizen of The City of Oklahoma City with demonstrated knowledge of the District.

§ 59-3450 STOCKYARDS CITY URBAN DESIGN COMMITTEE

§ 3450.3 Membership, Terms and Organization

A. Membership.

The Stockyards City Urban Design Committee shall consist of five members, whom the Mayor shall appoint with the consent and approval of the City Council. The Stockyards City Urban Design Committee shall be composed as follows:

~~(1) One (1) member shall be a member of the Planning Commission.~~

~~(2)~~ (1) One member shall be the Manager of Stockyards City Main Street, Inc. or a member of the Main Street Design Committee. If in the event the Main Street program is dissolved, then this position shall be filled by the President or another officer of any successor property owner or merchant organization.

~~(3)~~ (2) Three citizen members who shall be property or business owners from either the Stockyards City Development District and the Stockyards City Transitional Development District, provided that at least one (1) of the citizen members shall be from the SYD District.

(3) One member shall be a resident citizen of The City of Oklahoma City with demonstrated knowledge of the District.

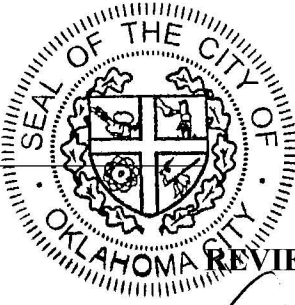
